Uterine Fibroids



Of the approximately 600,000 hysterectomies performed in the U.S. each year, about **60 percent** are for the treatment of uterine fibroids.¹

Although fibroids are **noncancerous**, they can cause significant harm to nearby organs, as well as anemia due to heavy menstrual bleeding.

These benign tumors are also known as uterine myomas, or leiomyomas.

Several factors may influence their formation, such as **hormones and genetics**.

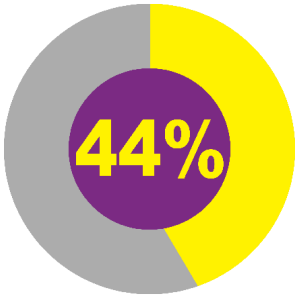
It is estimated that between **20 to 50 percent** of women of reproductive age have fibroids; however, many cases go undiagnosed.²

Studies show that up to **30 to 77 percent** of women will develop fibroids sometime during their childbearing years; although, only about one-third are large enough to be detected during a physical examination.³

UTERINE FIBROID EMBOLIZATION (UFE)



44% of women diagnosed with uterine fibroids didn't know there was a less invasive option.⁴

Our interventional radiologists perform Uterine Fibroid Embolization (UFE), an advanced, **non-surgical** treatment for uterine fibroids.

UFE allows women to avoid surgery, preserve the uterus, control symptoms, and improve their overall **quality of life**.


When compared to invasive surgeries like a hysterectomy or myomectomy, UFE continues to be the leading choice. Going through major surgery can be hard on the body. Invasive surgeries require a long recovery, sometimes lasting over 6-8 weeks.

The majority of women return to normal activities in **3-4 days**, with full recovery in **1-2 weeks**.

YOUR UFE PROCEDURE

Our UFE treatments are performed in state-of-the-art, outpatient suites.

Our interventional radiologists give a light sedation, prior to the procedure, so the patient does not feel anything.

They use ultrasound and X-Ray guidance to insert a tiny catheter, which is then threaded into the artery supplying blood to the fibroids.

A therapeutic agent flows through the catheter, blocking the arteries, which decreases the blood flow and causes the fibroid to shrink.

Stitches are not required and only a small bandage is placed over the access point. The procedure takes approximately 30-45 minutes.

HIGH SUCCESS RATE & LOW COST

The reported rates of patient satisfaction and improvement in **quality of life** after UFE, is 87 to 97 percent.⁶

UFE is known for its fast recovery period! There's no hospital stay, you're able to return home the same day, and you can get back to your normal, daily activities in 2-7 days.

Costs are currently **covered** by most insurance plans and Medicaid.
