

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING A UFE PROCEDURE?

On the day of the treatment, the fibroid specialist will use image guidance to infuse a therapeutic agent into the fibroid, which will result in the fibroid shrinking. Patients are typically out of the procedure room in 30 to 45 minutes.

Who is at risk for uterine fibroids?

Fibroids are common, and often a serious condition. Age, family history, ethnic origin, obesity and eating habits are some of the risk factors for uterine fibroids.

How do I know if I have fibroids?

Have you been told you have fibroids? If you are experiencing heavy and prolonged menstrual periods that continue for more than 5 days per month, or more often than 25 days apart you should contact USA Fibroid Centers for evaluation and treatment.

What is the recovery time for UFE?

Most women completely recover in 1-2 Weeks.

Is there any hospitalization required after a UFE Procedure?

At USA Fibroid Centers, UFE is performed as an outpatient procedure. After a short recovery, the patient can go home the same day after the treatment.

Can I resume having children?

According to a new study published online in the journal Radiology a minimally invasive treatment such as (UFE) can help restore fertility in women with uterine fibroids.*
